WHAT WE DO

Public transport services in Eurobodalla do not meet the needs of employers, employees, trainees, those going to medical appointments and other users. As a result, reliance on private cars is very high in the Shire. Reports released in 2020 and 2026 point to significant transport disadvantage in vulnerable population groups – yet tangible steps to improve the situation have not been taken.

SHASA has been trying to address these issues through grant applications and advocacy, with limited success. We don't have the capacity to give this issue the attention that it needs, and we are seeking a volunteer to fill this gap.

JOB SPEC

1. Work collaboratively with the SHASA transport committee.
2. Review our past work and available reports.
3. Work with specialists as required in community engagement and service design.
4. Develop a strategy to improve public transport services in Eurobodalla, including:
 - *community consultation*
 - *consultation with employment organisations, schools, Transport for NSW and other stakeholders*
 - *consultation with existing public transport operators*
 - *advocacy with local politicians and Council*
 - *write or assist with the writing of grant applications to fund strategy development and implementation*
